Indiana Manufacturers Association 2026 Vote Record Bill Summary

SB 4 - Taxation and Administrative Rules

Enhances oversight of the rulemaking process by lowering the cost threshold for mandatory budget committee review from \$1,000,000 to \$500,000.

SB 7 - Carbon Sequestration

Would have added burdensome local approval requirements for carbon capture projects; the IMA opposed this as it hindered environmental and economic benefits.

SB 189 - Nonparticipating Providers

Prohibits health insurance carriers from assessing administrative fees or penalties against healthcare facilities or providers specifically related to the delivery of care involving out-of-network (nonparticipating) providers.

SB 256 - Foreign Adversaries

Requires registration for agents of hostile nations and limits land ownership or educational enrollment for certain entities from foreign adversary countries.

SB 282 - Compounding Drugs & Medical Spas

Increases oversight and registration requirements for medical spas and drug compounding to protect the healthcare supply chain.

SB 277 - IDEM Modernization

Streamlines environmental permitting and requires fiscal analysis for any state rules more stringent than federal law to ensure “economic reasonableness.”

HB 1098 - Work-Based Learning Liability

Addresses worker’s compensation and liability issues for high school students engaged in work-based learning programs.

HB 1177 - Child Care Assistance

Expands the employer childcare expenditure tax credit to help more businesses provide or contract for childcare services for employees.

HB 1226 - Public Purchasing from Indiana Businesses

Establishes a price preference for state contracts awarded to businesses that manufacture, assemble, or produce supplies within Indiana, even if the business is not headquartered in the state.

HB 1335 - Nonprofit Hospitals

This bill mandates that nonprofit hospitals spend more on community benefits than the total estimated value of their state and local tax exemptions.

HB 1417 - Causes of Action

Aimed to reform civil law by limiting public nuisance causes of action; despite IMA support, the bill did not pass the Senate.
